Controlling Excellence Award 2024: Vetter Pharma-Fertigung, Österreichische Post and Robert Bosch are nominated

Award ceremony on April 29 as part of the 48th Congress of Controllers in Munich

The finalists in the competition for the ICV Controlling Excellence Award 2024 have been chosen. Vetter Pharma-Fertigung GmbH & Co.KG, Österreichische Post AG and Robert Bosch GmbH convinced the Jury with their submissions that they had found an exemplary controlling solution for their company. Head of the Jury Prof. Dr. Utz Schäffer reveals who wins the Award on April 29, 2024 at the award ceremony as part of the ICV Congress of Controllers in Munich.

The project of the **Österreichische Post AG** deals with an agile framework for the entire group controlling in order to be able to react better and faster to changing conditions. **Vetter Pharma** has set out to operationalize the Vetter Finance Strategy 2025 using the example of integrated corporate management. The aim is to further develop towards a holistic strategic and operational management concept based on fully integrated and automated data. At **Robert Bosch**, employees in the

myGreenBusiness department dedicated themselves to an IT-based approach to digitizing EU taxonomy reporting as part of the submitted project.

The winner of the ICV Controlling Excellence Award 2024 will traditionally present their project at the ICV Congress of Controllers and thus show the participants their excellent best practice solution from which they can also benefit in their own everyday professional life.
